DECISION

A Petition for Certification of Public Employee Representative was filed with the Commission on January 10, 1975 by the Trades Group of the Housing Authority of Jersey City. This petition was not supported by a showing of interest as required by the Commission's rules and as defined therein. (Rule Section 19:10-1.1 and 19:11-1.2 (a)9.)

On January 29, 1975 a letter was sent to the Petitioner indicating that the petition was not accompanied by a showing of interest as defined in the rules and that the petition could not be considered as complete. It was also indicated that the failure to submit the required showing of interest within three days may result in the dismissal of the petition.

Although the Commission Agent assigned to this matter has spoken with the Petitioner on several occasions, and the Petitioner has indicated that a showing of interest as defined in the Commission's rules would be provided, no adequate showing of interest has been filed as required by the above-cited rule. Additionally, the Petitioner has indicated that the petition would be withdrawn. No withdrawal request has been received.

Based upon the failure of the Petitioner to perfect the petition in accordance with the Commission's rules, and based upon the failure to withdraw the petition, the petition is hereby dismissed.
