## COLLECTIVE NEGOTIATION AGRESHENT

WHEREAS, the undersigned teachers' representatives have been designated by a majority of the present teachers employed by the Beard of Education of the Berough of Bloomabury, in the County of Hunterdon and State of New Jersey, as representatives of said teachers for the purposes of collective negetiation purposes to the New Jersey Employer-Employee Relations Acts

AND WHEREAS, these teachers' representatives have presented certain demands to the Board and the Board and the representatives have negetiated democrating the same and have dema to an agreement:

sow THEREPORE, WITHESSETH that the Beard of Education of said Berough of Bloomsbury and said teachers? representatives hereby agree that the following shall be included among the terms and conditions of employment for the new 1472-73 school year for teachers employed by this Beard:

- 1. The fellowing individual grievance precedure shall apply:
  - Step 1. Any teacher who has a grievance shall discuss it first with his principal in an attempt to resolve the matter informally at that level.
  - Step 7. If, as a result of the discussion, the matter is not resolved to the satisfaction of the teacher within one (1) salendar week, he shall set forth his complaint in writing to the principal. The principal shall communicate his decision to the teacher in writing within three (3) school days of receipt of the written complaint.
  - Step 3. The teacher may appeal the principal's decision to the Beard of Education. The appeal to the Beard what be in writing and set forth the grounds upon which the grievance is based. The Beard of Education shall request a report on the grievance from the principal, shall confer with the deminated perties and, upon request, with the beacher or principal separately. The Beard shall attempt to messive the matter as quickly as possible but within a period not to exceed thirty (30) calendar days. The decision rendered by the Beard shall be communicated in writing, along with supporting reasons, to the teacher and the principal.

- 2. The revised selary guide for teachers, a copy of which is annexed herete as Exhibit A, shall apply.
- 3. In addition to each teacher's other compensation, he or she will be entitled to be covered, if eligible, by Blue Cross and Blue Shield hespitalisation insurance, the cost of the premium for such individual teacher to be paid for by the Beard.
- teachers will be at school each school administration, all teachers will be at school each school day from at least enomhalf hear before the start of classes until enomhalf hour after the class of classes, and shall actend all teachers meetings called by the school administration.
- 5. Teachers will be allowed two personal leave days, with pay, which may be taken at their discretion provided they give the principal due notice of their intention to be absent.

  Any teacher who is absent more than two days, unless sick or excused by the school administration, shall pay the Beard the cost of hiring a substitute teacher to replace him, or her.
- 6. The school calendar for the 1972-73 school year shall be developed by the teachers and submitted by the teachers, in writing, to the Board of Education prior to April 15, 1972. The school calendar, as developed and submitted by the teachers, shall be adopted as the school calendar for the 1972-73 school year, unless the proposed calendar, submitted by the teachers, is veteed by action of the Board. In the event that the teachers fail to submit to the Board of Education a proposed school calendar by April 15, 1972, or in the event that no proposed school calendar which has been so submitted by such date has been found acceptable by the Board, then the Board shall have the right to develop and adopt a school calendar for the 1972-73 school year.

Motwithstanding the foregoing, the beard and the teachers and their representatives recognise that the calendar

which is adepted may be altered due to inclement weather, or other cause, which the school administration determines necessitates the cancellation of school sessions. The parties here to agree that in all events the school year shall consist of 180 days, and that any day, or days, which must be added to reach 180, shall be added at the end of the normal school year.

7. The Secretary of the Board of Education shall deduct yew Jersey Education Association dues from each teacher? a salary.

3. The Secretary of the Board of Education shall furnish at the end of each school year to each employee a list of sick days used by such employee in that year.

IN WITHESS WHEREOF, the teachers' representatives have signed hereunts on behalf of the said teachers and the Board has caused its proper officers to sign hereunts on behalf of the Board, this 17th day of February, 1972.
