The Petitioner has demonstrated by card check that a majority of the unit employees described below have designated the Petitioner as their exclusive representative for purposes of collective negotiations, and, no other employee organization has expressed a valid interest in representing these employees.

UNIT: Included : All regularly employed, supervisory, upper management, white collar employees employed by the City of Cape May.

Excluded : Managerial executives, confidential employees and non-supervisory employees within the meaning of the Act; professional employees, craft employees, police, casual employees, blue collar employees, and all other employees employed by the City of Cape May.
