TEMPORARY INJUNCTION

This matter being opened to the Commission by Theodore M. Simon, Esq., Counsel for the Charging Party, and the Respondent having appeared by its Counsel, James Major, Jr., and the Commission having read the Charge and Memorandum of Law filed herein, and having heard the oral presentations of the parties, and it appearing that good cause is shown,

It is on this 18th day of February, 1975,

ORDERED that the Respondent is temporarily restrained from fixing and determining a final budget that does not contain sufficient funds to implement the alleged agreement regarding the salary guide for the 1975-1976 school year, dated December 16, 1974, and it is;

FURTHER ORDERED that such temporary restraint shall remain in effect pending the expeditious disposition of the unfair practice charge herein, but shall in no event be in effect later than March 1, 1975.
