It is on this 27th day of March, 1975,


ORDERED that the Respondent show cause before the Commission at Workmen's Compensation Courtroom 11, 1100 Raymond Boulevard, Newark, New Jersey, on the 7th day of April, 1975, at 10:00 o'clock in the forenoon, E.D.T., or as soon thereafter as counsel can be heard, why an order should not be issued restraining and enjoining the Respondent from proceeding to arbitration on the matters concerning which the Petition for Scope of Negotiations Determination has been filed, pending the final determination of the Commission on said Petition, and it is,

FURTHER ORDERED that the parties shall file and serve their briefs on or before the 4th day of April, 1975, which briefs

shall address themselves not only to the merits of the requested interim relief, but also the specific question of the Commission's jurisdiction to restrain arbitration during the pendency of a scope of negotiations proceeding.
