
DECISION ON MOTION FOR RECONSIDERATION

On December 16, 1983, the Public Employment Relations Commission issued a decision in which it declined to restrain binding arbitration of a grievance the City Association of Supervisors and Administrators filed against the Newark Board of Education. P.E.R.C. No. 83-85, 9 NJPER __ (¶ ____ 1982). The Association then filed a Motion for Reconsideration of that decision insofar as the Commission suggested that the Board had a managerial prerogative to make temporary appointments during the period it posts notices and considers applications for permanent transfers or promotions. The Board opposes reconsideration. We have reviewed the parties' submissions and do not find the extraordinary circumstances necessary to justify reconsideration. Accordingly, we deny reconsideration.

ORDER

The Motion for Reconsideration is denied.
