## MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT (AGREEMENT)

THIS MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT (hereinafter: "Agreement") is Ortoberentered into this 13th day of September 2009 between the City of Long Branch (City) and Long Branch Firemen's Mutual Benevolent Association Local 68 (FMBA Local 68).

WHEREAS, the parties have negotiated and agreed upon the terms of an agreement with regard to Firefighters employed by the City for the period January 1, 2008 to December 31, 2013; and

WHEREAS, the parties desire to set forth the terms of this agreement; and

WHEREAS, this Agreement is a successor to a prior written agreement and interest arbitration decision and award (Docket No. IA-2005-003) (Award), which prior written agreement and Award covered the period ending December 31, 2007.

## NOW, THEREFORE, it is agreed as follows:

- The terms of the "WHEREAS" clauses are represented to be accurate and 1. true.
- Except as changed herein, the terms and provisions of the prior written 2. agreement and Award shall apply. The foregoing includes but is not limited to payment of step movement or guide movement, or any other payments even though in a particular year there may be no across-theboard increase.
- The term of this Agreement shall be from January 1, 2008 to December 3. 31, 2013.

- 4. 2008. No across-the-board increase, except that any employee with 29 years or more of service shall receive an across-the-board increase of 3% effective January 1, 2008.
- 5. 2009. No across-the-board increase.
- 6. 2010. Effective January 1, 2010, a 3% across-the-board increase and effective July 1, 2010 a 3% across-the-board increase. Effective January 1, 2010, there will be an annual contribution by each employee payable to the City equal to .5% of that employee's annual base salary, which is a contribution in connection with the City's annual increases for the cost of health insurance. This payment will be deducted from salary pro rated and taken out of biweekly paychecks.
- 7. Effective January 1, 2010, the sum of \$525 shall be paid as a stipend as a uniform allowance for each Firefighter. The aforesaid amount shall be paid annually in each year after 2010 effective January 1 of each such year. This payment is in lieu of and replaces the previous \$525 payment known as a "replacement uniform allowance for each Firefighter."
- 8. 2011. Effective January 1, 2011, a 3% across-the-board increase and effective July 1, 2011 a 3% across-the-board increase. Health insurance contribution of .5% shall continue.
- 9. 2012. Effective January 1, 2012, a 3% across-the-board increase and effective July 1, 2012 a 3% across-the-board increase. Health insurance contribution of .5% shall continue.
