The Captain shall receive total compensation of \$78,300.00 for the calendar year 2002; \$82,300.00 for calendar year 2003, and \$86,375.00 for calendar year 2004. There shall be no other compensation during the term of the contract.

SALARY:

The Captain shall not receive nor be entitled to any longevity payments.

LONGEVITY:

It shall be left to the discretion of the Chief as to when the Captain should wear formal or informal uniform or civilian clothes. The Captain shall be supplied with full and complete uniforms. The Captain is waiving any entitlement to a clothing allowance during the term of this contract. The Captain shall be responsible for cleaning and repairing of uniforms as needed.

UNIFORM:

The Captain shall be entitled to 5 personal days per year.

PERSONAL DAYS:

The Captain shall be entitled to 25 working days of vacation per year. Vacations may be taken at any time. However, the Chief and Captain shall not be on vacation or combination of vacation at the same time.

VACATIONS:

The Captain shall be assigned to a 40 hour work week and will perform duties as may be assigned or prescribed by the Chief of Police.

Annual Physical:

The Captain, with approval of the Chief of Police, shall be granted time off to attend any meeting of the above-named organizations. Township shall pay all reasonable expenses incurred by the Captain in attending any meeting of the above-named organizations held within the State of New Jersey and the meeting of the above-named organizations but payment of dues, by the Township, shall be handled on a case by case basis.

The Captain may apply for membership to other law enforcement investigators. The Captain may apply for membership to the I.A.C.P., N.J. State Association of Chiefs of Police, F.B.I., N.J. State Association of Chiefs of Police, or any other recognized law enforcement agency, organization or recognized training unit. Enrollment to such schools and seminars must be approved by the Chief of Police.

Professional Associations and Meetings:

The Captain shall be permitted to attend and be compensated for, at his regular salary, any school, seminar or training session conducted by or sponsored by, but not limited to the I.A.C.P., Division of Criminal Justice, N.J. Police Training Commission, N.J. State Police, F.B.I., N.J. State Association of Chiefs of Police, or any other recognized law enforcement agency, organization or recognized training unit. Enrollment to such schools and seminars must be approved by the Chief of Police.

PERSONAL DAYS:

The Lieutenant shall be entitled to 5 personal days per year.

UNIFORM:

It shall be left to the discretion of the Chief as to when the Lieutenant should wear formal or informal uniform or civilian clothes. The Lieutenant shall be supplied with full and complete uniforms and shall receive \$750.00 clothing allowance per year for cleaning and repairs.

LONGEVITY:

The Lieutenant shall receive four percent (4%) of his annual salary as longevity payment. Said longevity payment shall be paid, by the Township, on an annual basis, in the pay period immediately following the Lieutenant's anniversary date of employment with the Township.

SALARY:

The Lieutenant shall receive ~~a~~ base salary of \$61,299.00 for the calendar year 1999; \$63,904.00 for calendar year 2000 and \$66,620.00 for calendar year 2001.

SCHOOLS:

The Lieutenant shall be permitted to attend and be compensated for, at his regular salary, any school, seminar or training session conducted by or sponsored by, but not limited to the I.A.C.P., Division of Criminal Justice, N.J. Police Training Commission, N.J. State Police, F.B.I., N.J. State Association of Chiefs of Police, or any other recognized law enforcement agency, organization or recognized training unit. Enrollment to such schools and seminar must be approved by Chief of Police.

PROFESSIONAL ASSOCIATIONS AND MEETINGS:

The Township shall pay the Lieutenant's annual dues to the I.A.C.P., N.J. State Association, Gloucester County Police Chiefs Association and Tri-State Association of Criminal Investigators. The Lieutenant may apply for membership to other law enforcement organizations but payment of dues, by the Township, shall be handled on a case by case basis.

The Lieutenant, with approval of the Chief of Police, shall be granted time off to attend any meeting of the above-named organizations held within the state of New Jersey and the Township shall pay all reasonable expenses incurred by the Lieutenant in attending any meeting of the above-named organizations.

ANNUAL PHYSICAL:

The Township shall provide for the Lieutenant to receive an annual physical examination which shall include standard testing associated with the physical examinations, including EKG, cardiac stress test and eye examination.

MAINTENANCE OF STANDARDS:

1. The Lieutenant shall, at no time, receive less benefits, compensation, or percentage pay increases than those granted to subordinate officers of the Police Department. *However, the Lieutenant shall receive annual increases for advancing a Master Degree in a work related field.*
2. This agreement shall not be changed or amended except by mutual agreement, reduced to writing and duly executed by the





The Chief shall receive a base salary of \$99,984.00 for the calendar year 2005, \$105,813.00 for the calendar year 2006 and \$113,031.00 for the calendar year 2007.

SALARY

The Chief shall be entitled to twelve (12) holidays per calendar year as established in schedule "A".

HOLIDAYS

It shall be left to the discretion of the Chief as to when he should wear formal/informal uniform or civilian clothes.

UNIFORM

The Chief shall be entitled to five (5) personal days per year.

Approval of the Director of Public Safety of the Township Committee is vacant) shall not be on vacation or combination of vacation at the same time without the may be taken at any time. However, the Chief and Captain (or Lieutenant, if the Captain position is vacant) shall be entitled to thirty-five (35) working days of vacation per year. Vacation and Personal Days accrue on a pro rata basis, unless determined otherwise via subsequent clarification of the represented police units contract.

The Chief shall be entitled to thirty-five (35) working days of vacation per year. Vacation benefit days are credited as of January 1 of each year in anticipation of continued employment through the year. All partial employment years entitlements to Vacation, Sick Time, and Personal Days accrue on a pro rata basis, unless determined otherwise via subsequent and Personal Days accrue on a pro rata basis, unless determined otherwise via subsequent clarification of the represented police units contract.

VACATIONS, PERSONAL DAYS, SICK DAYS

The Chief shall have no designated work hours but shall maintain a flexible full time scheduling to ensure the smooth and efficient operation of the Police Department over which he has supervisory control. The Chief's flexible schedule shall allow for sufficient time at headquarters for appointments, public accessibility and such other normal and customary functions of a chief of police. It is further understood that the position requires the performance of duties outside of the traditional work day, such as attendance at various local government meetings.

The Chief of Police is responsible for the overall management and operation of the East Greenwich Township Police Department. The Chief shall devote his best full time efforts to the performance of such duties and responsibilities that are incidental, reasonable and necessary to his position and the mission of the Department.

MAINTENANCE OF STANDARDS

The Partnership shall provide for the Chief to receive an annual physical examination, which shall include standard testing, associated with the physical examinations, including EKG, cardiac stress test and eye examination.

ANNUAL PHYSICAL

The Township shall grant time off, and pay all reasonable expenses incurred by the Chief case-by-case basis.

The Township may meet any meeting of the above named organizations so long as the meetings are within a 150 miles radius of the Township. In the event any such meeting occurs outside of the 150 miles radius of the Township, the Chief shall first obtain permission to attend such meeting from the Director of Public Safety or the Township Committee.

The Chief shall be granted time off, with no loss of salary, to attend the N.J. State Chiefs of Police Conference, the I.A.C.P. Conference, the F.B.I. National Academy Association of Police Officers and other applicable law enforcement functions. The Township shall pay all conference and other applicable law enforcement functions. The Township shall pay all reasonable expenses for travel, hotel accommodations, meals and registration fees. The expenditure for conference shall not exceed the funds budgeted for each conference.

The Township shall pay the Chiefs annual dues to the I.A.C.P., N.J. State Association of Chiefs of Police, F.B.I. National Academy Association, South Jersey Chiefs of Police Association and the Gloucester County Chiefs of Police Association. The Chief may apply for membership to other law enforcement organizations, but payment of dues by the Township shall be handled on a pro rata basis.

SCHOOLS

The Township shall maintain a vehicle for exclusive use by the Chief. The vehicle shall be an unmarked unit, equipped with police radio, emergency lights and other such emergency equipment deemed necessary to carry out the law enforcement mission. The Township may issue a general statement for the use of the vehicle. In the absence of such policy, the Chief shall have unrestricted use of the assigned vehicle.


The Township shall notify the Chief or his spouse of their intent to change carriers. The Township by reimbursing the Chief may opt for the additional expense, if any, of such member/spouse rate. The Chief may opt for such other coverage as may be available through additional costs associated with prescription coverage over and beyond the cost of the prescription program, then the Township shall only provide supplemental coverage. The retired employee is eligible for federal/state health insurance through Medicare or some successor program, the Township shall not be entitled to the 30 day terminal leave benefit set forth in the East Greenwich Township Personnel Policies Manual.

RETIREMENT CONSIDERATIONS

Upon retirement, the Township agrees to continue in effect medical and prescription coverage for Chief Giordano and his spouse, under the same terms and conditions as such coverage is provided to members of the represented police unit. As there is currently no cost difference between prescription coverage for the member/spouse plan and the family plan, Grinspecc has indicated that retirees can opt for the prescription family plan at no additional cost to themselves. In the event of a future change of the Township's prescription plan provider's policy or rate differential between these two prescription plans, the Township will not be liable for any additional costs associated with prescription coverage over and beyond the cost of the prescription program, then the Township shall only provide supplemental coverage.

Captain may be entitled to five (5) personal days per year.

VACATIONS:

The Chief shall have no designated work hours but shall maintain a flexible time schedule allowing for sufficient time at his job to ensure the smooth and responsible operation of the Police Department over which he has supervisory control. The Township Committee recognizes the fact that the Chief's flexible schedule will allow for sufficient time at headquarters for appointments and public accessibility. The Township Committee further recognizes the Chief's record to avail himself for various local government meetings.

The base salary for the Lieutenant for the year 1991 will be \$38,473.00.

SALARY

The Lieutenant shall receive two (2%) percent of his salary as longevity payment in 1991. Upon completion of ten (10) years of service the Lieutenant shall receive three (3%) percent of his salary as longevity payment following the Lieutenant's anniversary date of employment with the township. Payments shall be paid by the township on an annual basis in the pay period immediately preceding the Lieutenant's anniversary date of employment with the township.

LONGEVITY

The Lieutenant shall be entitled to twelve (12) holidays per calendar year for which he shall receive eight (8) hours pay for each holiday in addition to his annual salary regardless of whether he works or does not work on such paid holidays.

HOLIDAYS

It shall be left to the discretion of the Chief as to when the Lieutenant should wear formal or informal uniform or civilian clothes. The Lieutenant shall be supplied with full and complete uniforms and shall receive 450.00 clothing allowance per year for cleaning and repairs.

UNIFORM

The Lieutenant shall be entitled to 4% personal days per year.

PERSONAL DAYS

The Lieutenant shall be entitled to 18 working days of vacation per year. Vacations may be taken at any time. However, the Chief and Lieutenant shall not be on vacation or combination of vacation at the same time.

VACATIONS

The Lieutenant shall be assigned to a 40 hour work week and will perform duties as may be assigned or prescribed by the Chief of Police.

Upon honorable severance or retirement from the police department, the Lieutenant shall be compensated for the following:

1. Twenty-five (25%) percent of accumulated sick time up to 960 hours.
2. Payment for unused vacation and personal days due during the current calendar year.
3. Compensation shall be computed at the current hourly rate of pay at the time of severance.

SEVERANCE/RETIREMENT
