AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE BOROUGH OF HAWORTH

AND

SCHOOL CROSSING GUARDS

FOR THE PERIOD OF

JANUARY 1, 1991 THROUGH DECEMBER 31, 1991

This agreement made and entered into in Haworth, New Jersey on the 12 day of July, 1991, by and between the Borough of Haworth and the School Crossing Guards. The parties agree to amend the Agreement between the parties which covered the period from January 1, 1988 through December 31st (hereinafter "Prior agreement") as follows:

Section 1:

The prior Agreement between the Borough and School Crossing Guards for the period January 1, 1988 through December 31, 1991 shall stay in full force and effect except as modified in Sections 2 and 3 hereof.

Section 2: Article V Compensation of the prior Agreement is amended to read as follows:

Article V Compensation: Guards shall be paid \$8.50 per hour during the year 1991. The guard presently posted at the Valley Road corner shall be paid \$.75 additional per hour for the duration of the contract.

At times, the guards are required to return to work at noon for half session of the school. At such times, they shall be paid for the full day.

The guards will be paid a day's pay for the Friday after Thanksgiving, the two days in November during which the

teachers are attending their convention, and Christmas day.


Section 3: Article X Term of Agreement of the prior Agreement is amended to read as follows:

Article X Term of Agreement. This agreement shall be for the term of January 1, 1991 to December 31, 1991 and the parties hereto agree to commence negotiations for the successor agreement effective January 1, 1992, not later than November 1, 1991. If the successor agreement is not executed by December 31, 1991, then this agreement shall continue in full force and effect until a successor agreement is executed.
