RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, the Board of Education of the City of Asbury Park has recognized the Asbury Park Education Association as the exclusive representative for collective negotiations for all cafeteria workers employed by the Board pursuant to N.J.S.A. 34:13A-5.1 et seq.; and

WHEREAS, representatives of the Board and the Asbury Park Education Association have entered into collective negotiations and have agreed that the provisions of the Collective Bargaining Agreement now in effect between the Board and the Asbury Park Education Association shall also apply to the cafeteria workers represented by the Asbury Park Education Association; and

WHEREAS, representatives of the Board and the Asbury Park Education Association have further agreed to wage scales for the various job titles in which the cafeteria workers are employed for the 1977-78 and 1978-79 School Years, copies of which wage scales are attached hereto; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Education of the City of Asbury Park has reviewed the terms of these Agreements;







BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the President of the Board be and herewith is directed and authorized to execute an addendum to the Collective Bargaining Agreement currently in effect between the Board of Education and the Asbury Park Education Association, which addendum shall amend the Recognition Article of that Agreement to include the cafeteria workers and also amend the Salary Schedules of that Agreement to include the attached wage scales for 1977-78 and 1978-79 for the cafeteria worker job titles. (The attached salary schedule shall be increased by eight (8) percent for 1978-79.)
