SIDE BAR AGREEMENT

The Borough of Roselle (hereinafter referred to as the Borough) and the PBA Local 99 (hereinafter referred to as the Union), representing certain police officer employees, hereby enters into this Side Bar Agreement this 7th day of October 2021 and hereby agrees as follows:

- Borough Resolution 2020-317 authorizes the Mayor and Council of the Borough to recognize Juneteenth Independence Day (June 19th) as a Borough Holiday.
- The aforementioned resolution did not independently modify existing Borough
 Ordinance regarding observed Holidays; however, amending ordinance shall be
 presented prior to June 19, 2021 in order to effectuate the addition of Juneteenth to the
 Borough Holiday schedule (listed in §5-17.C).
- Borough Ordinance Chapter 5, § 5-17.A (regarding Holidays) provides that the Police,
 Fire Department, and Public Employees Service Union are granted holidays and
 vacations pursuant to their respective collective bargaining agreements.
- The current PBA Local 99 collective bargaining agreement expires on December 31,
 2022.
- The Borough shall grant employees within the bargaining unit 2 additional personal days
 in consideration for the Juneteenth Independence Day for the remaining years of the
 collective bargaining agreement.
- 6. Future iterations of the collective bargaining agreement may include specific reservation of Juneteenth Independence Day as a recognized holiday.
