Resolution of the Board of Education
Asbury Park, New Jersey

WHEREAS, the Board of Education of the City of Asbury Park and the Asbury Park Administrative and Supervisory Association have, after a number of meetings, come to agreement regarding the salary schedule for the school year 1970-71; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Education of the City of Asbury Park and the Asbury Park Administrative and Supervisory Association have reduced their agreement to writing:

BE, IT, THEREFORE, RESOLVED

1. That the Board of Education of the City of Asbury Park hereby adopt an administrative salary guide which shall be calculated by placing each administrator on the salary guide for teachers, and adding thereto an incidence of responsibility ratio calculated as follows

ON AN ELEVEN MONTH CONTRACT:

High School Principal	1.54
Administrative Assistant to the Superintendent and Elementary Supervisor of Instruction	1.49
Middle School Principal	1.47
Elementary School Principal	1.43
Director of Student Personnel Services	1.38
Director of Inst. Materials Services	1.38
High School Vice Principal	1.38
Middle and Elementary School Vice Principals	1.32
Director of Special Education	1.32

ON A TEN MONTH CONTRACT:

High School Vice Principal	1.25
Middle and Elementary School Vice Principals	1.20

Any administrator thus placed on Step 10 of the guide, because of his prior experience being less than ten years, shall thereafter progress in the following manner: (1) after one year of service in the administrative position to Step 11 on the guide, (2) after two years of service in the position to Step 12 of the guide, and (3) after three years of service in the position to the maximum salary for the position.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED:

2. That the President and Secretary of the Board of Education of the City of Asbury Park be authorized by the Board to execute the agreement annexed in accordance with the provisions of Title 34, Chapter 13A-1; Senate Bill No. 746 effective July 1, 1968, which includes the agreements of the parties regarding the salary guide, all of which have been examined and approved by the Board of Education of the City of Asbury Park.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED:

3. That this guide be adopted as the policy of the Board of Education of the City of Asbury Park for the school year 1970-71 and that the agreement be filed with the New Jersey Public Employment Relations Commission.
