Art 1 Recognition

The Board of Education of the Southern Glovester County Regional High School District recognizes the Southern Glovester County Regional High School Custodian Exployees' Association as the exclusive representative for the bargaining unit consisting of custodian exployees, but excluding the supervisor of building and grounds.

Art. Il Grievance Procedure

A. Definition -

- 1. A "grievance" is an allegation that a specific province of this agreement has been violated.
- 2. A "Grievent" is an employee who files a grievance.
- 3. "Day" more calendar day. Saturdays, Sundays, and state mardated legal bolidays are excluded as the last day of the time list.
- 4. A "representative" is a person or agent designated to represent either party in the grissence procedure.
- 5. A "porty in interest" is a person, agent or agency with an interest in the gristance.

B. Procedures -

- 1. Grievances shall be processed promptly and expeditiously.
- Gricvaneas shall be adjudicated seconding to the terms of this agreement.
- 3. Formal gristmotos shall be in writing.
- 4. Observications and decisions concerning formal grievances shall be in writing.
- 5. Grisvances filed but not resolved under the terms of this procedure shall be resolved according to a mutually agreed time structure.
- 6. Parties in interest shall be permitted representatives limited to three (3) paraons at all levels of the procedures, and witnesses as determined by the bearing officer, provided requests for such are filed two (2) days prior to the bearing.

- 7. There shall be one (1) designated employer grickers representing the Costodial Association.
- 6. There shall be no additional evidence submitted during the griorence process, once a formal grievance has been filed.
- 9. Failure by a grievant to process a grievance within the specified time limit shall render the grievance as settled in favor of the Deard.
- 10. Failure to issue a decision within the specified time limit chall render the grievance sattled in favor of the grievant.

C. Processing -

1. Level 1 - Informal Grievances - a grievant shall discuss informally with his on her immediate superior any elleged violation of this agreement, within ten (10) days of such occurrence in order to resolve the grievance. Pailore to resolve the grievance shall advance the grievance to Level 2.

2. Level 2 - Formel Grievences -

- A. A grievant shall file a formal grievance within ten (10) days of the courrence of the grievance and shall specify the couse of the grievance, the nature of the grievance, the evidence and the remain sought. This information shall be placed on the appropriate grievance form.
- B. The ismediate empervisor shall hold a mosting prosptly with in five (5) days of receipt of the formal grievance, and shall rawler his or her ductation within five (5) days after the hearty.

1. Lovel 5 - Appetho for the Superintendent -

- 4. Atthin from (5) days of the decision at Level 2, the gulerrant may request and appeal to the Superintendent, the appeal small include all materials previously submitted.
- D. The Superintendent shall establish a hearing within ten (10) days following such a request and notify the grievant five (5) days prior to the hearing date.
- G. Five (5) days after the hearing is completed, the Supering tenders that notify the parties in interest of his decision on the mitter.

4. Level 4 - Appends to the Board of Education -

Gricydaeos appealed to the Board of Education shall be processed as in Level 1, except that the Board will establish a bearing within thirty (30) days. The Board shall forward its decision to the grievent within ten (10) days after the adjournment of the hearing. The decision of the Board in these matters shall be final and birding.

D. General Previsions -

- No projudice will strend any purify in interest by resease of the utilization or participation in the gristages proorders.
- 2. The filling or the productor of a grievance shall not impose the worms conagoners and operation of the school.
- 3. All records of grievaure processing shall be filled separately.
- A Forms for a gricuance processing shall be metually agreed up-a by the portion to the agreement. The Superintendent will distribute these forms as they are proded by employees.
- 5. Parties in interest will cooperate in intentigating and providing partitions information community a grievance being processed.

Art. 111 Burs of hork

The house of work for all employees covered by this southers shall be as attributed by the Board or Education.

Toronto Work Year

The work calendar of all employees in this bergaining unit shall be as established by the Dourd of Education.

Art. V Pork Continuation

- A. The Association agrees that during the lifetime of this agreement neither the association for any person acting on its bubble will cause, authorize, support or take part in any strike, concerted failure to report for work, willful absence of an employee from his or her positions, stoppage of work or other absence in whole or in part i from the full, laithful and proper performance of the employee's duties of exployment. The parties agree that no work stoppage, slowwerk, wellowed or other job action will be conducted against the Boord. The Association agrees that if such action should occur at will constitute a actorial breach of this agreement.
- i. In the event of a strike, slowdown, welkout, job ection or other form of concerted action it is agreed that participation in any such activity by any Association masher or any member of this bargaining unit shall emittle the Board to invoke the following such activity will be provide for termination of employment of each employment of each employment or unplayed or omplayed, subject to the provinces of state laws.
- C. The Association will sullively discourage and will take wherever affirmative steps are somewary to prevent or terminate any etrike, work groppings, aloudous, valuest or other job action against the Board.
- D. Bothing contained herein whell be construed to limit or restrict the Board in 168 right to seek and obtain such judicial relief as it may be entitled to have in law or inequity or injunctive relief or damage relief or both in the event of a breach of this provision of the contract by the Association, its numbers or bargaining unit numbers.

ART. VI. Management Rights

The Board reserves to itself and its agents full jurisdiction and authority over matters of policy and retains the right, subject only to the specific limitations imposed by the language of this agreement, in accordance with applicable laws and regulations: (a) to direct employees of the school district; (b) to hire, promote, transfer, assign and retain employees in positions in the school district and for just cause, to suspend, to demote, to discharge or take other disciplinary action against employees; (c) to relieve employees from duty because of lack of work or for other legitimate reasons; (d) to maintain the efficiency of the operations of the school district entrusted to the Board; (e) to determine the methods, means and personnel by which such operations are to be conducted; (f) to take whatever actions may be necessary to carry out the advice of the school district in situations of emergency.

ART. VII. <u>Fully Bargained Provision</u>

This agreement incorporates the entire understanding of the parties as all matters which were or could have been the subject of negotiations. During the term of this agreement neither party shall be required to negotiate with respect to any such matter whether or not covered by this agreement and whether or not within the knowledge or contemplation of either party or both parties at the time they negotiated or executed this agreement. This agreement shall not be modified in whole or in part by the parties except by an instrument in writing duly executed by both parties.

ART. VIII. <u>Duration of Agreement</u>

This agreement shall be effective as of July 1, 1979 and shall continue in full force and effect until June 30, 1986, subject to the Association's right to reopen negotiations one hundred and twenty (120) days before the required submission date of the school district's budget in the years 1981 82, 1982-83, 1983-84, 1984-85, 1985-86 on wages only. All other provisior of this contract shall remain in full force and effect until June 30, 1986
