NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Municipal Council of the City of Orange Township that the New Collective Bargaining Agreement between the City of Orange Township and the Orange Fire Superior Officers Association is hereby ratified and approved.



ADDENDUN TO ORANGE FIRE OFFICERS COLLECTIVE BARGAINING AGREEMENT EFFECTIVE JANUARY 1, 2005 THRU DECEMBER 31, 2008

- 1) NEWLY PROMOTED FIREFIGHTERS SHALL NOT RECEIVE SEMINAR DAYS.
- EFFECTIVE JANUARY 1, 2007, PRESCRIPTION COVERAGE SHALL BE AS FOLLOWS:
 - Generic Brands \$10.00 per prescription
 - Named Brands \$20.00 per prescription

ALL OTHER TERMS REGARDING PRESCRIPTION COVERAGE SHALL REMAIN IN AFFECT AS REFLECTED IN THE COLLECTIVE BARGAINING AGREEMENT.

- ANY EMPLOYEE WHO RETIRES AS A RESULT OF A WORK RELATED DISABILITY SHALL RETAIN AND IS ENTITLED TO FULL HEALTH BENFITS. EMPLOYEES RETIRING WITH NON RELATED WORK INJURIES ARE NOT ELIGIBLE.
 - NEWLY HIRED FIREFIGHTERS WHO ARE PROMOTED AFTER. JANUARY 1, 2006, SHALL BE PAID IN ADDITION TO THE RATES OF PAY SET FORTH HEREIN, A LONGEIVTY INCREMENT UPON YEARS OF SERVICE WITH THE ORANGE FIRE DEPARTMENT OR YEARS OF CREDITED SERVICE WITHIN THE RETIRMENT SYSTEM IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE FOLLOWING SCHEDULE:

COMPLETION OF 20 YEARS OF SERVICE -- PERCENTAGE INCREASE OF 10%.

COMPLETION OF 24 YEARS OF SERVICE - PERCENTAGE INCREASE OF 14%.

5) WAGE INCREASES SHALL BE PAID AS FOLLOWS:

JANUARY 1, 2005, 3% JULY 1, 2005, 1%

JANUARY 1, 2006, 3% JULY 1, 2006, 1%

JANUARY 1, 2007, 3%

JANUARY 1, 2008, 2% JULY 1, 2008, 1%

JULY 1, 2007, 1%

6) EFFECTIVE JANUARY 1, 2005, FIRE OFFICERS WHO RECEIVE A COLLEGE DEGREE FROM AN ACCREDITED INSTITUTION SHALL RECEIVE AN EDCUATION STIPEND AS FOLLOWS:

ASSOCIATES DEGREE---\$125.00 ASSOCIATES IN FIRE SCIENCE - - \$200.00 BACHELORS DEGREE - - \$250.00 BACHELORS IN FIRE SCIENCE - - \$500.00

7) A DEPARTMENTAL DRUG POLICY SHALL BE IMPLEMENTED PURSUANT TO THE DECISION OF ARBITRATOR AS REFLECTED IN PREVIOUS AWARD.

ALL OTHER TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF EMPLOYMENT NOT REFLECTED IN THIS ADDENDUM SHALL REMAIN IN AFFECT AS REFLECTED IN THE COLLECTIVE BARGAINING AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE OFA AND THE CITY OF ORANGE.
