Personal Days – Agree to not sell back in exchange for using or if not used by year end, converts to comp time – comp time for personal to be filled by part-timers 7 days a week - Comp Bank increase by 100 hours, for the duration of contract

Holidays- Agree to receive comp time instead of straight time. For the year 2010, but flexible for review at year end.

Incentives - Agree to forgo Gym and CPR incentive for the year 2010

Training Hours - Increase by 16 hours, for the duration of the contract

Shift Change - One Year trial of 24 hour shift and will review at year end. The change set to begin on or about March 8, 2010, depending on pay period. The schedule remains out of the contract.
