MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT

to the

SUCCESSOR AGREEMENT BETWEEN

THE PASSAIC BOARD OF EDUCATION (BOARD)

AND

THE EDUCATION ASSOCIATION OF PASSAIC (ASSOCIATION)

July 1, 2004 to June 30, 2005 September 1, 2004 - August 31, 2005

The Negotiating Committee of the Education Association of Passaic and the Negotiating Committee of the Passaic Board of Education have agreed to the following settlement of negotiations between the parties for the school year of 2004-2005. This agreement is entered into this ______ day of ______ by and between the Education Association of Passaic, hereinafter called the "Association" and the Passaic Board of Education, hereinafter called the "Board."

- 1. All items not contained in this Memorandum of Agreement are withdrawn for the 2004-2005 school year and shall remain as in the current agreement.
- The representatives of the Board and Association agree to the terms of this Memorandum of Agreement and further agree to recommend the items for ratification by the members of their constituencies.
- 3. The parties agree to an extension of the current agreement with the following exception: For the 2004-2005 school year, staff members will each work 20 one-half hour sessions to be utilized during the eight weeks prior to testing to prepare students for said testing.
- 4. The parties agree to increase salaries over the 2003-2004 base salary for employees as established by the scattergram summary, which includes employee data as of March, 2004. Salary distribution shall be mutually agreed upon. The parties agree to increases to salary and stipends of 5% in 2004-2005.
- 5. The stipend paid to teachers for an additional instructional period as referred to in Article 12.4 will be increased to \$1200 annually for each extra weekly class for the 2004-2005 school year.
- 6. The parties recognize Computer Technicians as members of the association.

The undersigned agree to submit and recommend ratification of this agreement to the respective parties. This Agreement is valid only after ratification by the Education Association of Passaic membership and the Passaic Board of Education.
