MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT

WHEREAS, the FMBA and the City of Orange Township have concluded negotiations for a successor Collective Bargaining Agreement; and

WHEREAS, the parties have reached tentative agreement on all issues which were subject of such negotiations;

NOW, THEREFORE, the parties agree as follows:

1. <u>Term:</u> The term of the new agreement shall be four (4) years commencing January 1, 2006, ending December 31, 2009.

2. <u>Salary:</u>	
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January 1, 2006 3% July 1, 2006 1%

January 1, 2007 3%.

July 1, 2007 1%

January 1, 2008 3%

July 1, 2009

- 3. <u>Prescription Co-Pay:</u> Effective upon ratification of contract, co-pays for prescription drugs will be \$10.00 for generic, and \$20.00 for brand names.
- 4. Clothing: Nomex shall be replaced with cotton.
