

AGREEMENT BETWEEN
 WOODBRIDGE BOARD OF EDUCATION
 AND

CARPENTER EMPLOYEES

FOR TERM OF JULY 1, 1969 THROUGH JUNE 30, 1970

1. PAY RATE 5.25 dollars per hour plus \$.50 per hour for foreman
2. TENURE Tenure after three years of continuous employment

4. VACATION Employees with at least six months continuous employment shall be granted 10 days vacation with pay each year
5. FAMILY DEATH
- Up to 5 days paid absence for death in immediate family consisting of husband, wife, children and any other member of the same household; also death of father, mother, sister and brother
 - Up to 2 days paid absence for death of near relative
6. SICK LEAVE
- Annual Sick Leave, with full pay, shall be granted in accordance with the following schedules:
 - Ten (10) school days for a carpenter with less than five (5) years of continuous service
 - Twenty (20) days for a carpenter with more than five (5) years, but less than ten (10) years of continuous service
 - Thirty (30) days for a carpenter with more than ten (10) years, but less than twenty (20) years of continuous service
 - Forty (40) school days for a carpenter with more than twenty (20) years of continuous service
 - Unused Sick Leave days in any school year, shall be accumulative to be used for additional sick leave as needed in subsequent years. The number of accumulated sick days is unlimited provided that not more than ten (10) days per year is accumulated.
7. P.E.R.S. Board will pay employer's share of Public Employers Retirement Systems payments as required by Title 18A
8. UNION PENSION AND WELFARE Board will pay a maximum of \$.25/hr. for pension and a maximum of \$.25/hr. for welfare to specified Union. Additional amounts will be paid only upon request and with the understanding that it shall be deducted from the base pay rate
