EMPLOYMENT AGREEMENT, made the 11th day of June, 1970, by, between and among PAUL POPADIUK, JOSEPH SFERRA and JAMES SIBILIA, members of the Borough of Raritan Police Department, (hereinafter sometimes referred to as "the members of the Borough of Raritan Police Department") and the BOROUGH OF RARITAN, in the County of Somerset, a municipal corporation of the State of New Jersey;

## WITNESSETH THAT:

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Raritan have negotiated with representatives of the Raritan Police Department, in accordance with provisions of R. S. 34:13A-1 et seq.; and

WHEREAS, the parties have agreed upon the salaries and other compensation to be paid to the members of the Borough of Raritan Police Department for the calendar year 1970-1971, as well as grievance procedure;

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the premises, the Borough of Raritan hereby employs, and the members of the Borough of Raritan Police Department hereby accept said employment, upon the following terms:

1. The annual base salary scale for the members of the Borough of Raritan Police Department shall be as follows:

- 2. In addition to the annual base salaries fixed in paragraph 1 hereof and as part of his annual salary, any members of the Borough of Raritan Police Department who has served for more than five years, but less than ten years, shall receive an amount equivalent to one per cent of his annual salary; any member of the Borough of Raritan Police Department who has served ten years or more, but less than fifteen years, shall receive an amount equivalent to two per cent of his annual base salary; any members of the Borough of Raritan Police Department who has served for fifteen years or more shall receive an amount equivalent to three per cent of his annual base salary.
- 3. Each member of the Borough of Raritan Police
  Department shall be paid for 12 holidays at his regular daily
  salary rate, payable on the first days of June and December.
- 4. Each member of the Borough of Raritan Police
  Department shall receive an annual uniform allowance of \$150.00.
- 5. A member of the Borough of Raritan Police Department appearing before any municipal court as part of his duties outside his assigned duty hours shall be compensated at the rate of \$3.00 per case.

- 6. Appearance by a member of the Borough of Raritan Police Department, as part of his duties, before any grand jury or at any County, Superior or Supreme Court proceedings, except a civil action, shall be governed by R. S. 40:11-13.9.
- 7. The salaries and other compensation of members of the Borough of Raritan Police Department shall be paid bi-weekly.
- 8. The salaries and other compensation provided for in this Employment Agreement shall be retroactive to January 1, 1970.

- 9. The grievance procedure governing the employment relationship created hereby shall be as set forth in the Rules and Regulations of the Borough of Raritan Police Department. Said Rules and Regulations as pertain to grievance procedure shall not be amended without the prior written consent of the members of the Borough of Raritan Police Department.
- 10. This Employment Agreement and the employment relationship created hereunder shall remain in full force and effect until midnight, December 31, 1971, except that the provisions of paragraph 2 hereof shall remain in full force and effect until midnight, December 31, 1971, and shall not be subject to negotiation by either party prior thereto.
