ARTICLE I

RECOGNITION

The Board recognizes the Association as the exclusive and sole representative for collective negotiations and conditions of employment for all part-time night school instructors under contract by the Board.

ARTICLE II

TEACHER EMPLOYMENT

- 1. New employees shall be placed on the salary guide at a level acceptable to them and the school district.
- Employees will be issued contracts by September 1st of each year. Discontinuation of employment shall be made in writing.
- 3. Full-time staff members who are responsible for a shop area shall be given the courtesy of first option on night school positions in their areas.
- 4. The Association will supply a list of officers to the Board by October 1st of each year.

ARTICLE III

SALARY GUIDE

CLASS I INSTRUCTOR

These positions are defined as those needed for a trade, industrial and vocational education. To include persons who, in addition to classroom theory, must supervise equipment or practical application of theory in a shop or instruct persons who will use this skill for a livelihood.
