THIS ACREEMENT, made this 22nd day of March , 1970 letween:

THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE BOROUGH OF RINGWOOD, herei. after colorred to as the "Council" and

THE RINGWOOD POLICE ASSOCIATION, hereinafter referred to as the 'Association',

WITNESSETH:

MHEREAS, the Council and the Association have met and negotiated with each other and have reached an agreement regarding wages and terms and conditions of employment, which toth parties desire to place in writing;

NOW THEREFORE, in commideration of the mutual covenants and conditions contained hereis and for other good and valuable consideration, it is mutually agreed as follows:

1. The basic pay scale for the calendar year 1972 shall be as follows:

Change in pay status for all Petrolmen shall be effective on the anniversary late of their appointment.

A longevity plan for the benefit of patrolsen and officers having the designated minimum years of service is granted as follows:

Provided however, that in addition to the salary above set forth, beginning on the first day of January of the sixth

year of service, each eligible police officer shall receive two (2%) per cent longevity payment and the same shall be payable for each succeeding two year period until a maximum of ten (10%) per cent of the scheduled sclary has been attained, provided further that the said schedule of longevity payments shall remain in effect noted that the said schedule of longevity payments eligible officer.

- 3. Any interruption of mervice, due to a cause beyond the control of the efficer or patrolmen, such as military service, injury in the line of duty or illness, shall be considered as service for the Barough of Ringmod for the purpose of determining the completion of soid consecutive periods of service with the Borough.
- 4. A uniform allowence of Two Hendred Fifty (\$250.06) Dollars shall be permitted, embject to proof by vencher.
- a) Provided the following is precessed by a day cleaner chosen by the Berough of Ringwood, the said Berough will pay all charges for the elecating of one uniform ecocisting of one jacket, one pair of pasts and one shirt, for each and every full time member of the Police Repartment, per week.
- 5. The members of the police department shall be emtitle to the same number of vecation days as are allowed the other employees of the Berough of Ringwood under their Union Contract for 1972, provided however, that the days shall not be the same and shall be determined by order of the Chief of Police.
 - 6. Cumulative sick days shall be allowed as fellows:
- a) One day for each menth of service during the first calendar year of service.
- b) Fifteen (15) days you commun for each calendar year of service thereafter.
 - c) In the event any member of the department shall

become disabled by reason of a service connected injury and is unable to perform his duties, then in that event, he shall be compensated at the full rate of pay for a period of six months, provided however, that in the event there is any compensation payable to the petrolman or member of the Department from insurance or other source, the monies recovered shall be delivered and paid ever to the Borough up to the amount paid by the Borough to the petrolman in lieu of salary.

- d) With permission of the Chief of Police, any three (3) days of the period previded in a), b) or c) above, may be taken as personal days.
- e) Sick leave shall be considered for the following reasons:
- (1) Illness or injury, except when directly traccable to employment by an employer other than the Berough of Ring-wood and where illness or injury is compensable under State Landon and the compensable under State
- (2) Where the illums or injury shell continue for three or more days, then in that event, a medical sertificate shall be required to be filed with the Chief of Police.
- 7. The Association members shall receive the same hospital benefits and coverages as provided for the other employees under the Union Contract, provided however, that in addition thereto, the Berough of Ringwood shall furnish false arrest insurance for each and every member of the Association.
- 8. The Association members shall receive the sum of Twenty (\$20.00) Dollars for each day as they may be required to appear and give testimony in any other sourt other than the Ringwood Municipal Court.
- 9. In the event any number of the regular Police Department shall perform a tour of duty for a private person or contractor, at other times than during the regular tour of duty, then in that event he shall be paid at his regular hourly rate.

with deductions for any payment directly received by him from the private person or party or contractor.

- 10. In the event any member of the department shell attend an accredited college or university and study subjects or attend classes related to the improvement of his professions status, in that event, he shall be reimbursed by the Bereugh by the rate of one half (1/2) of actual cost of tuition, provided the said maximum reimbursement shall not exceed Three Hundred (\$300.00) Dollars per year provided he attain a minimum
- 11. Provided that this section shall become effective only from the date of the execution of this agreement by both parties, members of the Police Department shall be paid overtime at the rate of time and a half, under the following circumstances:
- (1) Whenever an officer is off duty and is directed to fill in a shift.
- (2) Whenever an officer is required in the course of a bonafide investigation to complete such investigation which requires immediate action, and in the event that the time required to complete the investigation shall be in excess of one hour, said time to run from the time of the completion of his normal shift.
- (3) At any time that any off duty officer is called during a bonefide emergency.
- (4) At any time where a particular efficer is called for specialized duty, where the efficer on duty cannot perform the said duty or when deemed necessary by the Chief of Pelice to maintain a normal police function.
- 12. It is agreed by and between the parties that this contract shall be for a period beginning January 1, 1972 to December 31, 1972, and all benefits granted herein, with the exception as set forth in paragraph 11 above, shall be retro-

active to January 1, 1972.

16. This agreement shall be binding upon the parties hereto and their respective successors and assigns.
