## ARTICLE III GRIEVANCE PROCEDURE

### A Definition:

- A "Grievance" shall mean a complaint by a worker or group of workers or the Association based upon the interpretation, application or violation of this Agreement, policies or administrative decisions affecting them.
- A "Grieved" is the person or persons making the claim.
- 3. A grievance to be considered under this procedure must be initiated in writing by the worker within thirty (30) calendar days from the time when the worker knew or should have known of its occurrence.

- 1. (a) Fallure at any step of this procedure to communicate the decision on a grievance within the specified time limits shall permit the apprieved employee to proceed to the next step. Fallure at any step of this procedure to appeal a grievance to the next step within the specified time limits shall be deemed to be an acceptance of the decision rendered at that step.
- (b) It is understood that employees shall, during and notwithstanding the pendency of any grisvance, continue to observe all assignments and applicable rules and regulations of the Board until such grievance and any effect thereof shall have been fully determined.
- 2. The Association may process a grievance through all levels of the grievance procedure even though the aggrieved person does not with to do so.
- Any employee who has a grievance shall discuss it first with the Supervisor in an attempt to resolve the matter informally at that level.
- 4. If, as a result of the discussion, the matter is not resolved to the satisfaction of the employee within five (5) school days, he shall set forth his grievance in writing to the Assistant Superintendent specifying:
- (a) The nature of the grievance
- (b) The nature and extent of the injury, loss or inconvenience
- (c) The results of previous discussions
- (d) His dissatisfaction with decisions previously rendered
- The Assistant Superintendent shell communicate his decision to the employee in writing within five (5) school days of receipt of the written grievance.
- 5. The employee, no later then five (5) school days after receipt of the Assistant Superintendent's decision, may appeal the Assistant Superintendent's decision to the Superintendent of Schools.

- The appeal to the Superintendent must be made in writing reciting the matter submitted to the Assistant Superintendent as specified above and his/her dissatisfaction with decisions previously rendered. The Superintendent shall attempt to resolve the matter as quickly as possible but within a period not to exceed ten (10) school days. The Superintendent shall communicate his decision in writing to the employee and the Assistant Superintendent.
- 6. If the grievance is not resolved to the employee's satisfaction, he, no later than five (5) school days after receipt of the Superintendent's decision, may request a review by the Board of Education. The request shall be submitted in writing through the Superintendent of Schools who shall attach all related papers and forward the request to the Board. The Board, or a Committee thereot, shall review the grievance and shall render a decision in writing within thirty (30) calendar days of receipt of the grievance by the Board.

- 7. If the decision of the Board dose not resolve the grievance to the astisfaction of the Association and it is an alleged violation of the express terms of this Agreement and if the Association wishes review by a third parry, they shall so notify the Board through the Superintendent within tan (10) school days of the Board's decision, except in the case of grievances involving any of the follow-
- ing points:

  (a) Any matter for which a method of review is prescribed by law or any rule or regulation of the Commissioner of Education or State Statue or regulation such as, but not limited to, questions on tenure, increment denial or suspension.
- (b) Any matter which according to law, is either beyond the scope of Board authority or limited to action by the Board alone, except as limited by Chapter 123, Public Law 1974.
- (c) A complaint by an employee occasioned by the withholding of a salary increase or increment.
- 8. For those items specified as non-arbitrable, the Board shall, if requested by the grievant, meet and hear the grievant's position.

- cistion or Public Employment Relations Commission to submit a roster of persons qualified to function as arbitrators in the dispute in question.
- (2) If the parties are unable to determine a mutually-satisfactory arbitrator from the submitted list; they will request the American Arbitration Association for Public-Employment Relations Commission to submit a second roster of names.

  (3) If the parties are unable to determine within ten (10)

  (3) If the parties are unable to determine within ten (10) school days of either the initial request for arbitration or the second request, which comes after, a mutually satisfactory arbitrator from the second submitted list, the American Arbitrator from the second submitted list, the American Arbitration Association or Public Employment Relations Commission may be requested by either party to designate an arbitrator.
- (b) The arbitrator shall limit himself to the issues submitted to him and shall consider nothing else. He can add nothing to nor subtract anything from the Agreement between the parties or any policy of the Board of Education. The decision of the arbitrator shall be final and binding upon both parties. Only the Board and the aggrieved and his representative shall be given copies of the arbitrator's award. This shall be accomplished within thirty (30) calendar days of the completion of the arbitrator's hearings.
- (c) Rights of employees to representation:
- (1) Any aggrieved person may be represented et all stages of the grievanca procedure by himself, or, at his option, by a representative selected or approved by the Association. All documents, communications and records dealing with the processing of a grievance shall be filed in a separate file and shall not be kept in the personnel file of any of the participants.

  (2) When an employee is not represented by the Association in the processing of e grievance, the Association shall, at the time of submission of the grievence to the Superintendent or any later level, be notified that the grievence is in process, have the right to be present and present its position in writing at all hearing sessions held concerning the grievance and shall receive a copy of all decisions rendered. A copy of the Assistant Superintendent's written decision made in response to a written grievance shall be given to the Association immediately.
- (3) The Board and the Association shall essure the individual freedom from restraint, interference, coercion, discrimination or reprisal in presenting his appeal with respect to his personal grievences.

(d) The parties shall be responsible for all costs incurred by each, and only the fee and expenses, if any, of the arbitrator shall be shared by each party paying one half (%).

If any provision of this Agreement or eny application of this Agreement to any amployee or groups of employees is held to be contrary to law, then such provisions or application shall not be deemed valid and subsisting, except to the extent permitted by law, but all other provisions or applications shall continue in full force and effect.

# ARTICLE XXIX CONTINUITY OF OPERATIONS

A. The Association acknowledges and agrees that the employees of the Board of Education, which it represents, are prohibited by law the right to strike or to engage in any other concerted job actions such as work stoppages, stow-downs, stck-outs, which would disable or diminian the efficiency of the Board of Education, in the discharge of its Constitutional or Statutory duties. Further, the Association agrees that any such action as stated above would constitute a material break of this Agreement.

# MECHANICS NIGHT SHIFT

- A. The night shift will be an eight (8) hour shift.
- B. Assignment to the night shift will be by seniority with the most senior mechanics having the right to reject the assignment and the junior mechanics having to accept the assignment if the complement is not filled.

## ARTICLE XXXII REPRESENTATION FEE

- A. The Association shall, on or before September 30, deliver to the Board a written statement containing the following:
- A statement that the Association has determined the amount of representation fee in accordance with the formulated requirements of N.J.S.A. 34:13A-5.4.
- A statement that the Association has established a "demand and return system" in accordance with the requirements of NJSA 34:134-5.4.
- A statement establishing the amount of yearly representation fees to be deducted from the salaries of each non-member. Such representation fee shall not exceed eighty-five percent (85%) of the regular membership dues, fees and assessments.
- 4. A list of all employees who have falled to arrange for and become members of the Association and a request that the representation fee of such non-members be deducted in accordance with the Agreement.
- B. Beginning with the first full pay period in November, the Board will commence deductions from salaries of such employees in accordance with paragraph C below, of the full amount of the representation fee and will promptly transmit the amount so deducted to the Association.
- C. Payroll Deduction Schedule:

The Board will deduct the representation fee, in equal installments, as nearly as possible, from the psychecks paid to each employee on the aforesald list, during the remainder of the membership year in question. The deductions will begin with the first psychecks:

- In November, or .
- 2. Thirty (30) days after the employee begins his/her employment in a bargaining unit position, unless the employee previously served in a bargaining unit position or was on lay-off, in which event, the deductions will begin with the first paycheck paid ten (10) days after the resumption of the employee's employment in a bargaining unit position, whichever is later. The mechanics for deduction of representation fees and the trensmission of such fees due to the Association, as nearly as possible, shall be the same as those used for the deduction of regular memberahip to the Association.
- D. On or about the last day of each month, beginning with the month this Agreement becomes effective, the Board will submit to the Association, a list of all employees who began their amployment in e bargaining unit position during the proceeding thirty (30) day period. The list will include names, job titles, and dates of employment for all such employees.
- E. The Association hereby agrees to indemnify, defend, and save harmless the Board from any claim, suit, or action of any nature whatsoever which may be brought at taw or in equity, or before any administrative agency with regard to or arising from the deduction from the salaries of any employee of any sum of money as a representation fee under the provisions of this Agreement.

## ARTICLE XXXIII DURATION OF AGREEMENT

A. This Agreement shall be effective as of July 1, 1985 and shall continue in effect until June 30, 1988 subject to the Association's right to negotiate over a successor Agreement as provided in Article II. This Agreement shall not be extended orally and it is expressly understood that it shall expire on the date indicated.
