MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING
BETWEEN

THE TRENTON BOARD OF EDUCATION

THE TRENTON BUSINESS AND TECHNICAL EMPLOYEES ASSOCIATION

- 1. Promotional Increments. Any employee promoted shall have his/her salary in the new position determined by advancing two steps on the old position guide then moving to the step on the new guide which is equal to or next higher than the figure after the aforesaid adjustment.
 - 2. Supermaximum. Additional pay for college credits shall be provided to employees hired after September 1, 1987 only if those credits are earned while employed in the District.
 - 4. <u>Vacations</u>. Any vacation of 3 consecutive work days or more must be requested of the immediate supervisor at least 10 days in advance.
 - 5. Overtime. Add Art. III, Section 6
 All overtime assigned under Sections 4 and 5
 shall be assigned by the immediate supervisor
 and approved by the appropriate Assistant
 Superintendent.
 - 6. Retirement. A. Effective July 1, 1987, post retirement health benefits shall be provided for employees (individual only) retiring after age 55 with at least 25 years service to the District until the employee is eligible for Medicare.
 - B. Effective July 1, 1987, credit for unused sick days in accordance with the present formula may be obtained upon retirement after 20 years of service to the District.
 - 7. Dental. Effective July 1, 1987, full family dental coverage will be provided through either Delta Dental or DSO.
 - 8. Uniforms. If the Board requires an employee to wear a uniform (including special shoes), the Board shall either provide said uniform and shoes to employees or annually pay employees an allowance of \$75.00 for uniform and \$50.00 for shoes to be paid by February 1 of each year. This provision shall be retroactive to July 1, 1986.

V July 1, 1987 - June 90, 1989

9. Salaries. Any and all stipends and supermaximum payments have been included in calculation of base salaries and placement hereunder. There will be no further stipends paid over and above salaries.

For 1986-87, salary placement shall be determined as shown on Attachment A, and the difference shall be paid in a lump sum retroactively.

Salary guides for the years 1987-88 and 1988-89 are attached as exhibits B and C respectively. In 1987-88, employees shall advance one step on their salary guide, and in 1988-89, they shall advance another step. If movement requires addition of a step during the term of this contract, the step shall be calculated by increasing the last step by the average increment percentage for that guide.

Assignment of titles to salary guides shall be as set forth on attachment D.

10. This agreement is subject to ratification by the Board and the Unit's members.
