The Board of Education of the City of Trenton and the Trenton Food Service Personnel Association agree as follows:

- 1. The contract between the parties dated July 1986 through June 1988 is modified as follows:
 - A. Article 9, change present B to Bl.
 Add: "B2. Employees laid off in accordance
 with paragraph Bl shall have bumping rights
 based on overall seniority within the unit,
 calculated from date of hire, into Iower
 classifications for which they would meet
 normal requirements of the job."
 - B. Article 13, add: "The Board of Education shall consider reimbursing the employee for any damage to personal property belonging to the employee which occurs while the employee is performing his or her regular duties on a case by case basis. The employee shall report such loss to his or her immediate supervisor."
 - C. Article 14, add:

H. The Board of Education shall grant a child rearing leave without pay to an employee for up to two years from the date of birth of the employee's child, or, in the case of adoption, up to two years from the date of adoption.

D. Article 16: \$5 55.05

Longevity shall be paid to salaried employees pro rata based on daily hours, i.e. 8 hour employee 100%; 6 hour employee 75%; 4 hour employee 50%:

After 15 years - an additional \$200.00 After 20 years - an additional \$400.00 After 25 years - an additional \$400.00 After 30 years - an additional \$400.00 After 35 years - an additional \$400.00 After 40 years - an additional \$400.00

E. Article 17, add to A:

After 25 years service to the District upon retirement at 55 years of age or older, the Board shall continue individual coverage for the employee until eligible for Medicare.

- F. Article 16, add:
 - F. The President of the Association shall be notified by the Food Service Department in writing of all appointments, resignations, transfers, retirements, extended leaves and/or death of any unit members. This notification shall be made simultaneously with notice to the Personnel Department.
- G. Salaries will be increased 6.5% effective July 1, 1988. Hourly rates will be increased 6.5% effective July 1, 1988. Additional sums due hereunder shall be paid in a lump sum in a separate check to be delivered with the employees' final paycheck in June 1989.
- H. The parties agree to immediately continue negotiations for a two year successor agreement in the impasse mediation process on three issues only:
