

AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE TOWNSHIP OF MOUNT HOLLY AND THE MOUNT HOLLY SUPERVISORY POLICEMEN'S ASSOCIATION.

THIS DOES NOT CIRCULATE

I. Recognition.

The Township hereby recognizes the Mount Holly Supervisory Policemen's Association as the exclusive collective negotiations agent for all police lieutenants. A statement of the officers of the Association shall be filed with the Township and shall be maintained in an accurate condition.

II. The following sections of the Agreement between the Township of Mount Holly and the Association of Mount Holly Police Department Employees, dated 4-1-79 are hereby incorporated by reference into this Agreement unless specifically noted to the contrary:

- Section II - Management Rights
- Section III - Association Rights
- Section IV - Fully Bargained Provisions
- Section V - Employment Responsibilities
- Section VI - No Strike Pledge
- Section VII - Grievance Procedure - This section is amended to delete all references to immediate supervisors, to provide that the Chief of Police will serve as the immediate supervisor, and to delete subsections C2 and C3
- Section VIII - Terms of Agreement - This section is amended to stipulate that the Agreement will govern only police lieutenants.
- Section IX - Uniforms, Equipment and Personal Articles
- Section X - Working Conditions B
- Section XV - Subsection B (Evaluation Procedure) - This subsection is amended to delete all references to immediate supervisors and to provide that the Chief of Police will serve as the immediate supervisor.
- Section XV - Subsection C (Longevity)
- Section XI - Overtime
- Section XII - College Credit
- Section XIII - Leave Provisions
- Section XIV - Medical Benefits
- Section XVI - Indemnification of Members
- Section XVII - Separability and Savings Clause

III. For 1979 and 1980, the Township will pay members in accordance with the following pay plan subject to Section XV, Subsections B and C above.






